

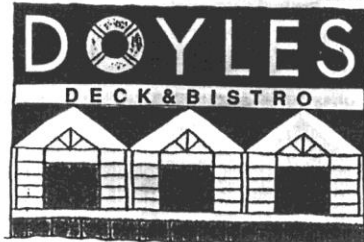

PLAYER PROFILE BARRY SWEENEY

A fine young ambassador for NEW ZEALAND arrived at the club in June of last year and he has quickly established himself both as a player and a clubman. BARRY was born in the land of the long white cloud of IRISH and SCOTTISH parentage, and started playing soccer for his home town DUNEDIN at the age of seven. In 1982 the family moved to AUCKLAND the year BARRY remembers N.Z. beating O.Z. to reach the WORLD CUP finals, he joined EAST COAST BAYS a club pertaining to have the largest junior membership in the Southern Hemisphere. After filling many positions in the side he eventually found his ideal position as a central defender and helped the team win two league titles and three cup competitions. EAST COAST BAYS in 1989 had one of the best U19 sides in NEW ZEALAND and BARRY became a part of the side. The season was to prove a disappointment for BARRY as injuries plagued his year and he was eventually forced to miss the finish of the season.
