# REPORTS FROM AROUND THE CLUB

**FOOTBALL** What can we say ! Russell Black, his staff and squad have done the job again so far and we are hoping for promotion to Division 2 in 1997. The Juniors are performing well and there are some good boys coming through down the line (see separate report).

FACILITIES - The lights from Robinsons Road are to be relocated on the main Junior pitch at Ballam Park over the next few months. The lights are neither the correct height nor power for Senior Match Standard, but are more than adequate for Ballam Park. Some minor pitch maintenance will be done by the Club over the summer to bring the main Junior pitch back up to top standard.

The Centenary Park pitch is holding up well - the council are doing a great job helped by our small band of volunteers. The pitch will be closed over the summer months for replanting and some modifications. At the same time the Club will be carrying out further landscaping works.

Car parking is an increasingly major problem. At this stage the Council believe that the best option is to develop land behind the pitches off Dulker Court for parking. Our main spectator entrance would then be behind the stand. The McClelland Drive entrance would be used only for staff, officials and players. The Council sees the future for the complex as a fully enclosed spectator facility with limited parking inside the complex. The Rugby pitches are likely to become passive recreation areas - no decisions yet.

A working group is being formed to prioritise the installation of Match Standard lighting at Centenary Park, ideally before the 1997 season commences. All necessary permits have been obtained and the Council is assisting the Club with the project. Council has already established that there is a long term supply of methane gas available from the old tip which can supply generated power for the lights (and Club) at considerable saving.

Clubroom renovations will be undertaken over the next twelve months at both complexes using the balance of funds available (\$15,000) from the Long Island Cricket Club. The funds held in trust by the Council are available to us from now on in progressive amounts for Council approved Clubhouse projects.

MARKETING/SPONSORSHIP - We are confident that Tooheys will support us for a second term in a major way. McDonalds (Karingal & Tower Hill) continue to provide great support for our Juniors and we have acquired many new Club Sponsors. We hope to fill the fences at Centenary Park with signs by the end of the season. The media continue to give us good coverage which is reflected in our match attendances. Membership has increased and we thank you all for your support. Membership of the Club is the BEST way to show that you care. IT'S NOT TOO LATE TO PAY FOR THIS YEAR!

FINANCE/ADMIN - Savings have been made in all areas of the Club's operations except "on the park". Income has increased - mainly through efforts to build crowds at home games and additional social functions (thanks Dave Taylor). This has enabled us to reduce our debts to 30 day trading accounts only, other than our ANZ Overdraft and a small amount owing to Council as progressive payments for Ground Rates. We expect to reach 30th September with 30 day accounts only. Special thanks must be made to Jack Elsworth and his volunteers at the bar, Jan Cummings and her Car Raffle team and Tommy Weir and the Groundworks/Matchday team. Of course, the same people figure in all groups.

The AGM is coming up in October. We need help both on and off the Committee. Make a decision for next year - are you a DOER or a TALKER??

SOCIAL - The diary has been pretty full this year with Club events and outside bookings. Both Clubrooms are available for private functions.


