VSF Leagues Restructure - 1998

"The VSF Commission resolved at its meeting on May 20 1997 that commencing in 1998, State League Divisions 2 and 3 would be declared amateur divisions (Division 4 will remain amateur). The decision was made following consultation with the State League Management Committee and regional meetings with the State League Clubs. The Commission believes that this decision will alleviate the financial burden and pressures that are imposed on clubs by the current regulations."

(Extract from VSF Memo to Clubs - 21 May 1997)

We trust that this decision will be coupled with an imminent restructure of Leagues based on facilities, members, administration, etc.. The implications are that Premier League and Division 1 are to become quite distinctively the elite Leagues of Victorian Soccer.

We believe that the ball is now even more in our court to make an all out effort and win promotion into Division 1 in 1998. The Committee is working hard with the Frankston Council to ensure that our facilities meet all VSF criteria (parking, pressbox, etc.) and we are confident that our other "off the park" services are up to scratch.
