I was able to watch half of the Langwarrin game last week at home against Stonnington, the blues finished winning 4-0, however the referee doing a great job all day sent off three of the Stonnington players, nobody could argue with the decision of the send offs, apart from the away teams bench and spectators.

The end result of all this was that the Police were called to ensure that the referee was safe from any trouble. I am told that a number of Police cars and a divi van were in attendance at the ground.

The Langwarrin committee did the right thing in closing the bar for an hour, this action and the presence of the Police cost the Club money in lost revenue. This situation will be all to familiar to many ex players here today, I myself remember playing for Frankston City at Green Gully, we were unable to commence the second half because the spectators of green gully were trying to smash down our dressing room, we were winning at the time.
