MATCH REPORTS

STRIKERS LOSE

Frankston Strikers' winning run came to a halt at the weekend with an away 0-2 loss to promotion seeking Richmond.

Playing without injured player-coach Russell Black, Strikers were under pressure from the start from a well drilled, more experienced Richmond side. In the first half Strikers made a number of incisive but fruitless runs into their opponent's goal area but for much longer spells Richmond were in command, always quicker to the ball and stronger physically. At times it seemed like their forwards were lining up at the edge of the Strikers penalty area all eager to score, but the goals would not come. Some poor finishing and solid defensive work from Andy McKenna, Graham Watson and Tony Beasy, kept the match scoreless at the turn.

The second half opened with more of the same pressure on the Strikers goal and five minutes in Richmond were rewarded with their first goal. Strikers came back into the game for a time after that, but soon they were being pinned back with relentless Richmond attacks and in the 70th minute they got their second goal. In the time remaining Strikers defence held firm and stopped any further scoring.

Best for Strikers were McKenna, Watson and Beasy.

The reserves got back on to their winning form to win 1-0 in a tough hard fought match and kept their league winning hopes very much alive.

STRIKERS WIN AGAIN

Frankston Strikers got their third win in a row when they beat Cranbourne Comets 3-1 at Centenary Park at the weekend.

Strikers started well with early pressure on their opponents defence and were soon rewarded in the 15th minute with a clever solo goal from Michael Moore. Cranbourne woke up and for long spells the game see-sawed from end to end. Andy McKenna and Graham Watson were solid in the Strikers defence well supported by Marcus Brownlie and Danny Williams and up front Kris Patterson and Craig Wright were causing Cranbourne a lot of problems. Towards the end of the half Frankston were on top again when Cranbourne broke away and grabbed an equaliser.

In the second half Strikers had the edge almost throughout. In the 70th minute they missed a penalty but made up for it a few minutes later with a second goal from Craig Wright. Tempers began to flare and after a couple of incidents two Cranbourne players were sent off. Moore grabbed a Strikers third goal in injury time.

Best for Frankston was Watson, McKenna, Patterson and Moore but all players in the team played their part in the impressive win.

The crucial reserve match was marred from the start with no official referee turning up. The young Strikers dominated most of the game but an angry incident 15 minutes from the end with the score 0-0 caused the game to be abandoned.

Coaches Report

Our defeat against Richmond brought our 3 match run to an end.

The last game against Cranbourne was in my opinion the best win of the season so far and with a little bit better finishing we could have quite easily doubled the score.

Last week I felt we performed poorly and were outplayed for long spells against a physically stronger Richmond side.

Today we welcome Stonnington who handed us our biggest defeat of the season, and I'm sure the players will be looking to avenge that result and pick up the three points. On the injury front it was good to see Robbie Currie making a successful comeback (even though the plaster was still on) last week and Alex Rae has resumed training so hopefully wont be too long before he is available for selection.
