## Coaches Report

### Reserve Team

#### Cranbourne:

Since taking over, I have struggled with the fact that the lads have been struggling to run out the full game ( due to their lack of pr-season I guess )some of the boys are lacking in condition and this has cost us dearly nearing the final 20 minutes of our matches so far. Cranbourne scored to lead 2-1 and as predicted we couldn't find the drive and the know-how to counter a challenge. We were slightly disappointing at the fact that Cranbourne are a much younger side than us and our strength over the concluding stages of the game let us down.

#### Springvale city:

The main focus for this game from our perspective was that this game being fought out to the end regardless of the score. The introduction of Steven Mc Avoy back from Seaford would give us an opportunity to find some balance in the side. The squad size is increasing with new lads fronting up at training this week and expected to be signed for our game against Stonington next week.
