FROM THE PRESIDENTS CHAIR

The VFF inquiry over the cancelled game at ENDEVOUR produced its findings last week. Thankfully no blame or fine was put on our club however what could best be described as a slap on the wrist (small fine and bond) was put on ENDEVOUR.

To go on I must stress when writing this section of the programme it is sometimes my views only and not those of our club committee. From the above enquiry I believe a lot of the blame lay's at the feet of the VFF. Over the passed decade many clubs have come through from the Provisional League in to the State League, with , bit it fair ,good sides but with very little else. In attempting to increase the number of clubs thus players the VFF have really opened a can of worms. One remembers when KARINGAL could go no further up the ladder due to the fact that they could do nothing to their ground and thus merged with FRANKSTON. Yet since then many clubs like ENDEVOUR have come in to the State League virtually on park pitches, grounds not enclosed save for a rope hopefully put around the ground and no race to ensure the players safety. In the interests of the game the Australian Football Federation bit the bullet on the old National League and in a few weeks time a re born competition will start, Should the VFF do like wise regarding clubs ground conditions and say that progress from the Provisional League should only happen if their grounds match a certain criteria. If football is to progress to a higher level all this should apply To finish I regard LANGWARRIN as a prime example of the correct way to do things both on and off the park they have strived to give the club good facilities and have got good results on the pitch and it did not come easy.
