From the above enquiry I believe a lot of the blame lay's at the feet of the VFF. Over the passed decade many clubs have come through from the Provisional League in to the State League, with, bit it fair, good sides but with very little else. In attempting to increase the number of clubs thus players the VFF have really opened a can of worms. In the interests of the game the Australian Football Federation bit the bullet on the old National League and in a few weeks time a re born competition will start, Should the VFF do like wise regarding clubs ground conditions and say that progress from the Provisional League should only happen if their grounds match a certain criteria. If football is to progress to a higher level all this should apply To finish I regard LANGWARRIN as a prime example of the correct way to do things both on and off the park they have strived to give the club good facilities and have got good results on the pitch and it did not come easy.
