Peter, who is one of the youngest players in the team, was born in Cardiff, South Wales and is one of the "Taffys" in the team. For the best part of his youthful life he lived in a Welsh village, and at the age of nine attended Cowbridge Grammar School, where he played both soccer and rugby. He played for the School First Eleven as Goal-keeper until he left England in May 1947.

Before coming to Australia, he lived for a short time in Cristchurch, New Zealand, and played for a local team as goal-keeper.

This season he played his first game for Frankston on the Right Wing, but for the rest of the season he has played in his familiar position of goal-keeper, where he shows great promise. As spectators will agree he has played some great games this season.

This afternoon he is playing in the Outside-Right position where he also shows promise.
