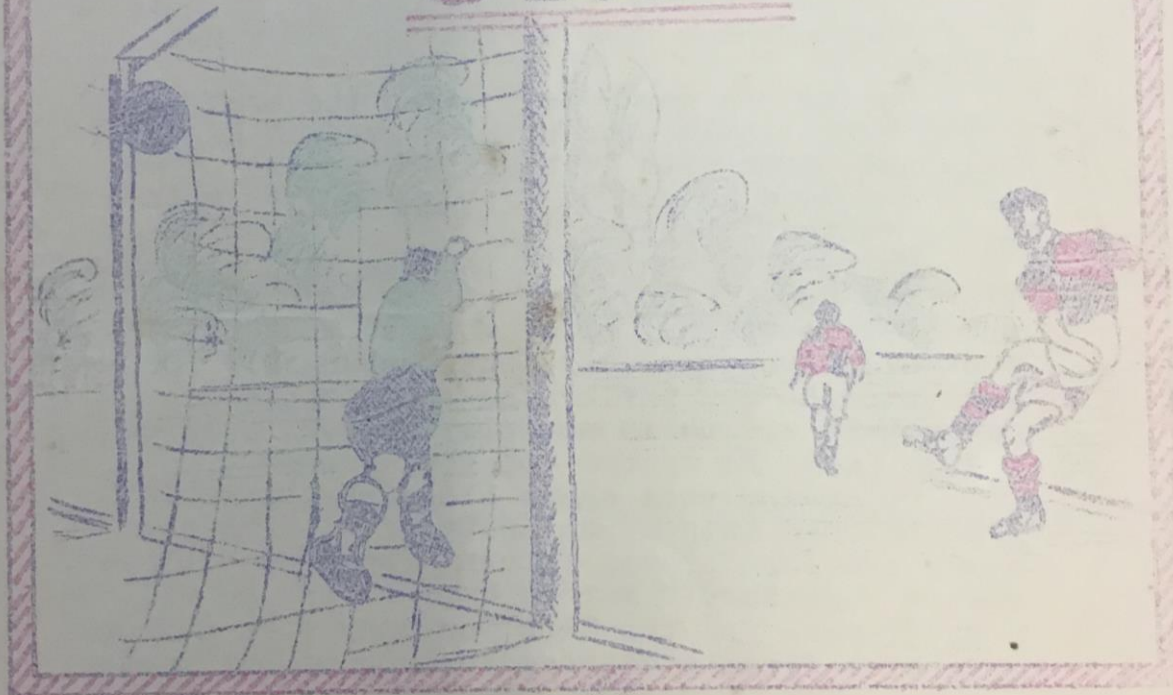

This week the spotlight is on our Vice-Captain and hard-working Secretary, P. Ims. (known as 'Percy' to players, supporters and spectators alike)

He started his playing career in England with Margate Central School and played for "Margate Boys". On leaving School he played in the Senior "London Thursday League" as Outside-left, during which time he won two Cup Final medals.

During the war Percy joined the army and played very little soccer. He served in Nigeria, India and Burma with "Wingate's Chindits". On being demobbed he played with a local team in a Sunday football League.

He came to Australia in June 1950 with his wife and son (Brian), two of the Club's most ardent supporters. Percy thought that his football days were over, but fortunately for Frankston he was influenced to postpone his retirement and he is now playing very well as Inside-Left. He is our top goal-scorer.

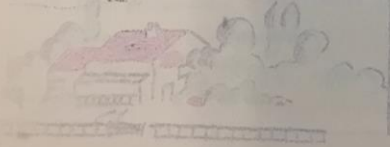
