# Star sets game alight

**FORMER English International Martin Chievers (Pictured), set the Frankton-Western Suburbs game alight with a sparkling debut for Frankton City.**

Although he finished this game without a goal to his credit, he was totally responsible for all three City goals scored by Dave Webb, Billy Buchanan and Kevin Wall.

Western Suburbs were not however a three goal worse team. Chievers was the difference adding some superb touches and deft flicks that had the crowd gasping with admiration.

He had far more impact than last year's guest Martin Peters, which proves that front runners make the difference.

The effect Chievers had on 19-year-old Kevin Wall was amazing. The youngster revelled in the service he was getting, and put in a magnificent game.

Western Suburbs had no answer to Chievers' skill, sometimes surrounded by four players he would still manage to organise himself out of it, to find a telling pass to a colleague.

The first goal came after 15 mins when Chievers deftly touched on a Bruce Young corner for Webb to head home a superb goal.

Chievers combined well with Wall to set up a great chance, the youngster unselfishly returning to Chievers who had made position again, only for the former England star to hit the side netting with a stunning effort.

After the interval Chievers was majestic. Playing a little deeper he continually built up Frankton attacks with some superb passes.

It came as no surprise when City went into a 2-goal lead shortly after Chievers sent Wall away on the left with a telling pass which completely split the Suburbs defence.

Wall turned about and found Billy Buchanan, who had come on for the hard worked McClusky. Buchanan drove home with a neat bit of finishing. Suburbs weren't out of it however and looked extremely dangerous at times. Bill Whiteside had handled things well most of the game and denied Suburb's every chance of a Consolation goal.
