MATCH JOTTINGS

FRANKSTON 0 JUVENTUS 1

Their experience, combined with our remaining forwards and midfielders, could have given the bite required to tilt the scales. However, the boys played well enough not to be disgraced in the least by the score sheet. Our defence played well against the wind and Petergen had the added disadvantage of a strong sun in his face - the clouds came over during the break! He managed to keep the score down to 0-1 at half time with some magnificent saves. In the second half, Frankston had more of the play as Juventus had in the first half - about 60-40 - but the Juve defence held fast and made a few breakaways as City did against the wind.

City once again belied their position on the ladder, giving us a display of soccer worthy of a much larger attendance.
