At 1 nil for most of the day it was Aaryn "Rixy" Rix who sealed the win late in the second half. As the season rolls on, our reserve team strengthens and many of these players are pushing senior players for selection. I believe this is a healthy situation for the club to be in as many wait for their chance / break for senior selection. All I will say is, your turn will come, be patient train and play hard, keep a good attitude and support your fellow players and the club. Keep the Faith, your turn will come.

Members / Supporters: - I would like to take this opportunity to those of you who have supported the club, I'm sure you all enjoyed the win last week as much as everyone else did. I'm sure your support helped get our lads over the line. Let's encourage our teams again this afternoon and get behind the lads once again. For those of you that weren't with us last week, this year marks the 20th year since Karingal United Soccer Club and Frankston United Soccer Clubs amalgamated to form Peninsula Strikers FC. There are many of you who were a part of those two clubs 20 years ago, who are still involved with Peninsula Strikers today; a club of tradition pride and loyalty, to you, I thank you for your support.

Junior's members and Mascots: - It was absolutely fantastic to see our first group of junior mascots here last week. I would like to thank the parents of the U9s who attended last week. It's fantastic for the kids to be involved with our senior team, so many of our senior players commented on the big smiles on the kids' faces last week, something they will remember and talk about for a long time, including their game at half time in front of a terrific crowd. It's our pleasure to provide a free hot dog, lollies and a drink to all mascots on game day.

Please remember that all juniors who attend match day should use their senior's member's card to obtain a bag of lollies and a drink on game day (If you don't have one please see your team coach or manager). As you would be aware junior parents gain free admission with their child when you present your card on match day.

Happenings / Club Projects / Future Vision:-

Without a vision Peninsula Strikers FC remains the same. So where are we heading what's on the table at the moment? - After having land fill placed at the rear of the current training ground which currently cannot be used as it hasn't any irrigation, therefore the grass died. At the moment we are currently negotiating with council to have this rectified, as this didn't occur and was promised in the outset. We hope that this will be completed by the end of the season. We are negotiating once again for the club to contribute in kind to have this project undertaken total cost 30K. Once completed we will have two(2) training grounds and another competition ground running lengthways across the width, enabling our club to expand from the current six (6) teams this season with only 3 in 2012. We hope this will accommodate at least 3 more teams in the near future, while giving club teams a greater area for training.

New Training Lights:-

After many years of sub-standard lighting, I am happy to inform you that this week the clubs Special Projects Manager (Peter Stuckenschmidt and myself had our first meeting with council. At this stage the club has agreed with council after being confirmed by members of the Soccer Liaison Committee (Representative of all Clubs) who agreed that our current lighting requires upgrading. We should know if we have been successful after the end of Oct 13 with the project to commence in 2014.

Pergola / Covered Area Club Entrance:-

After having the concrete completed in exposed aggregate recently by "Burdetts" one of our very generous sponsors. PSFC committee have decided that the concrete area at the entrance side of the club should be covered 1st. I have a sponsor to provide the materials for the roof; the club will have to pay for the vertical metal posts (12) ourselves. A Stalwart and great supporter of the club Kevin McGuiness has offered to erect the roof for the club with his employee's thank you Kev. If anyone knows a Draftsman we require drawings to be completed for submission to council for approval. If anyone is, or knows a draftsman who would like to donate their time, please let me know. We would love to provide the improvements to the club and better facilities for your pleasure / comfort and enjoyment.

NPL (National Premier League):-

In mid-2012 FFA announced a new competition throughout Australia called the (National Premier League) this competition commenced in all other states this year. Prior to the clubs AGM last year, your committee sat down and looked at a vision for Peninsula Strikers FC. One of which, was to investigate and work towards putting the club on the map and having our club / consortium provide an opportunity for players across all age groups with the best coach's available at each level to play at the highest level locally, in a competition across the state of Victoria.

National Premier League will sit one (1) below the "A" League Melbourne Victory & Heart. This league will encompass Men's and Women's competitions from juniors thru to seniors with the competition commencing in Feb14 - Nov14. This is a huge concept and if you would like to know more please visit the FFV website for more info. In early December last year all clubs in the local area met with council including councillor Colin Hampton and representatives of the FFV to discuss the possibility of having a team on the Peninsula. During this meeting PSFC informed other clubs of our interest in NPL. This meeting was led and organised by (Michael Woodward) the club Secretary. Due to the late release by the FFV it's been difficult to inform all club members of the committee vision and interest in this competition. At the present time your club has placed an expression of interest with the FFV. We have been speaking with various sponsors including those current whom have shown interest. This will cost the clubs who gain a licence a great deal of money to run each year, with the licence costing 50K, rest assured we are out there exploring the possibilities with many potential sponsors. While there is much work still to be done, there is a glimmer of light that this could occur. I will update you as things come to light.

Once again, I thank you all for your continued support and hope you enjoy your day.





Firstly, it was with pleasure that we welcomed Harry Johnstone back as Goal Keeper after the first encounter with the Dandenong Wolves in the first round when he incurred a dislocated shoulder. We had expected some uncompromising play but nothing like the antics portrayed at the game on the weekend.

The condition of the pitch was heavy and this translated some otherwise great kicks into non-descript passes and feeble attempts at goal.

Nevertheless, Anders Jaeger scored the first goal from the left wing, around seven metres from the corner flag, curving the ball past the keeper into the top right corner of the goal. The remaining goal was the result of a penalty taken by Aaron Vega.

There was an unprecedented seven punitive cards issued in our game but none were against Peninsula Strikers. Full credit must go to the referee who upheld the integrity of the game regardless of his exposure to physical and psychological violence. Peninsula Strikers players, officials and spectators must be commended for their exemplary behaviour in the face of offensive, aggressive and abusive conduct perpetrated by our guests.
