## Senior Coach Report



Although last weeks result against Beaumaris was not the ideal start we would have liked, there were a number of positives to take from the game. The tempo and display in the first half of the game was very encouraging and was representative of what we have been working on during our pre season games. With a bit more luck in front of goals, we could have put Beaumaris in a tough position for the second half of the game. Unfortunately we conceded a very soft penalty that leveled the scores at half time after Ali Osmani had headed in our opening goal of the game and the 2015 season.

Returning to the pitch for the second half, we faced a very strong wind which made it difficult to defend against a tall, strong, direct Beaumaris. That being said, our defending was not at the level we would expect and we paid the price for a lack of desire and determination to protect our goal. I have reinforced the message to our players that we need to defend with determination, discipline and a strong desire if we are going to have a chance at winning games. This was not the case in the second half of the game. After we conceded our second goal, our team structure and shape lacked discipline and we failed to make any significant in roads back into the game.

When rebuilding a new football team, it will take time to find the level of consistency and performances that we demand and expect. There were some positive signs that we are heading in the right direction and I am confident with the group of players we have at the club this season we will be back to winning ways and delivering consistent, strong attacking performances this season.

I have said all along that this season is about rebuilding our Football club both on and off the pitch and it was very encouraging to see our supporters turning up in numbers and supporting the team like they did in round 1. I would like to thank them for their support and to assure them that we will continue to work with the playing group to play the attacking, exciting football which will encourage them to return each week.

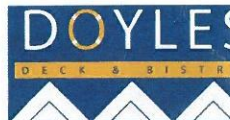
