"Go Strikers"

"Chris Crewther, Liberal candidate for Dunkley at the upcoming Federal Election, announced with Treasurer the Hon. Scott Morrison MP on Wednesday 25 May that a re-elected Turnbull Coalition government will commit funding of \$410,000 to the Peninsula Strikers Senior FC for women's sport.

It is intended that these project funds be used to enable the construction of female friendly facilities at McClelland Reserve.

Not only that, these funds will provide for a multi-purpose facility that meets the current and future needs of the community. The project funds will deliver two additional change rooms with supporting amenities that are female compliant.

Sport and Recreation Victoria has already committed to allocating \$100,000 towards the development of the facility. The \$410,000 in Federal funding will enable completion of the much needed structure.

This funding will provide a more functional and inclusive facility and increase female participation in soccer. Chris looks forward to working with the Peninsula Strikers Senior FC to see through the completion of this project, to benefit women's sport and involvement in soccer across the region."

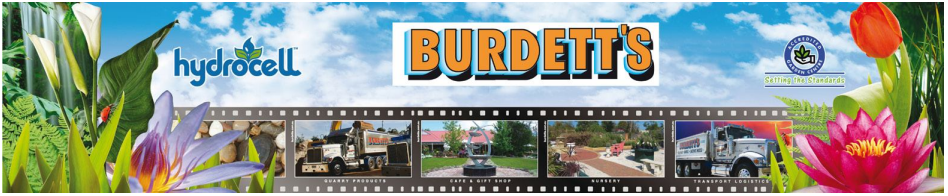
