A Word From The Coach

We must take our chances

Today we welcome Heatherton United to Centenary Park in what is a must win fixture for us. The past two weeks we have only managed to collect 1 point out of 6, which is disappointing after collecting 6 points for the two local derby's against Seaford and Pines the previous weeks.

Although we have only collected 1 point from the past two matches, we have showed that we can control the games where we apply ourselves as a collective unit. Our last home game against Old Scotch, we played some really good football, however a series of missed chances ensured we did not take the 3 points in which we had worked so hard for.

Last week away against Beaumaris, we also controlled the majority of the game with some strong possession, however once again we missed a host of chances to easily have won the game comfortably. Unfortunately our own defensive errors continually hurt us. These individual errors are something we must remove from our games if we are to give ourselves any chance of collecting maximum points each week.

Overall the past 4 weeks as a team we have created at least 25 to 30 opportunities, however we have only managed to take 4 of those chances. We must be more clinical in the attacking third of the pitch and show the sharpness and ruthlessness required in front of goal when the opportunities arise.

In the past week, Leandro Parrella our Italian Import has decided to seek pastures new and has officially signed for NPL2 side Werribee. This came as a surprise to the president and coaching staff as discussions were held without our knowledge nor permission. Although we are disappointed losing Leandro, we shall move forward regardless and continue to strengthen the playing group when the right players present themselves.

One final point I would like to address is discipline. Particularly to the match officials during games. I am the first to admit my frustrations have got the better of me at times and I take full accountability for my indiscretions, however, the playing group has also been addressed over the past week with regards to the lack of discipline shown during games. Not only to match officials, but also to our opponents, back chatting the coaching staff and our own team mates. This must stop immediately as we seen last week against Beaumaris, we were without 3 players because of suspension. As a small playing roster, we cannot afford to have players missing games due to disciplinary issues.

Let's take our chances today and claim the 3 points at home. Our supporters deserve to see their team win 3 points at home
