The UNITED missing persons bureau is looking for JIMMY SMART who appears to have dissappeared from our soccer scene.

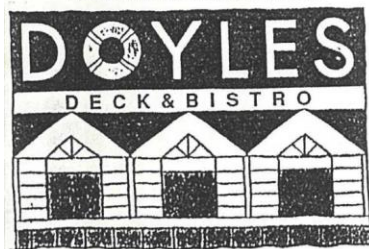
