## **Frankston Soccer Club**

The Club has been formed by the amalgamation of the 25 year old Karingal United Soccer Club, the 6 year old Frankston United Soccer Club and Frankston United Junior Soccer Club. The new Club is now the largest soccer club in Victoria and in 1994 expects to field 6 Senior teams and 19 Junior teams. Additionally the Peninsula Junior Soccer Club is an affiliate Club bringing a further 13 Junior teams under the Club's umbrella.

The purpose of the amalgamation is to unify the soccer interests in the Frankston area to promote the game and provide better facilities and opportunities for family, sporting and recreational activities based around soccer.

The aim of the Club is to reach Premier or National League status as quickly as possible by positioning the Club to take advantage of a major League restructure being undertaken in Victoria in 1995. This restructure by the Victorian Soccer Federation is already underway and is based on grounds, facilities, membership, Junior Development, local identity, management, etc..

The enthusiasm generated by the amalgamation is evident by the immediate support being received from the Victorian Soccer Federation, the Frankston City Council and local Members of Parliament.

Most of the elected Committee have served at least three years on Soccer Club management bodies and bring a wide diversity of talent and expertise to the new Club. Major long term commitments have been made by several large sponsors which will guarantee the sound financial structure of the Club for the future.
