President's Blurb



Welcome to round 19 of the 2013 season - Peninsula Strikers Vs Heatherton. We welcome all players, members, friends and families including those visiting players committee and spectators of Heatherton United. I sincerely hope you all have an enjoyable afternoon with us.

Federal Government Funding for Training Lights: As many of you would be aware last Monday week we received some fantastic news for the club with the announcement of \$120,000 for lights for our training park, this something as you would be aware we have been trying to achieve throughout this season. The following statement was released by me to the media: New Training Lights Give Strikers Vision to Expand After over 30 years of substandard training lights at Peninsula Strikers FC, a recent announcement by the Federal Minister for sport Don Farrell last week, will enable the club to rapidly expand once our new lights are fitted, after the Rudd Labor Government announced \$120,000 in funding towards this major project. The funding will be used to light up the club's pitches and training areas.

Labor Candidate for Dunkley, Sonya Kilkenny, said the funding would help deliver outstanding facilities, which was a great win for the club and the community. "This funding will provide the Peninsula Strikers with the support they need to continue their vision of a strong, inclusive and active Frankston community," Ms Kilkenny said.

"With this Federal funding, the Club's vision of pathways for female players, social players, indigenous and CALD (Culturally and Linguistically Diverse) community involvement is strengthened."

Club President Mark Brandon said the Federal Government funding would complete "years of hard work by club members" determined to provide a pathway for juniors players and broaden community involvement in the Club.

"This project will benefit each and every one of our 450 members both Junior and Senior players once completed, and allow us to involve and engage the wider community" Mr Brandon said.

18 months ago soil excavated from Peninsula Link Fwy provided an extension to our current training ground. This area has since been fitted with irrigation and will be seeded at the end of our current season by FCC, seeing the training grounds ready for use early next year. Funding for new training lights, will cover our entire training area, which is just fantastic. It will enable the club to now expand, benefiting all age groups / teams, now and in the future.

Over the past 3 years we have been working together with Frankston City Council, the training area has been increased to help the club fulfil its vision. This expansion was urgently required, as the club this year had reached maximum capacity and had to turn players away. PSFC will create another competition ground, once the training area is complete, at McClelland Drive. In 2013, PSFC have added 3 new teams, one in the local Bayside FA and 2 teams to the Football Federation Victorian competitions. Our first ever ladies team was entered in State 4 this season, this now creates a pathway for junior females. Female soccer is one of the fastest growing sports, in our area and in Victoria. In another first for the club, a young men's team was entered in Metro 6, creating a future pathway for junior males who don't initially make our senior Saturday teams. PSFC also added a U35 men's team into the Bayside FA, on a Sunday morning.

Club President Mark Brandon explained, this new funding would ensure players who decided previously to give up the sport, or who were required to go to other clubs in the area, now had an option to continue with the club as we can now expand as a club in the future. Funds for the project are already included in the Budget.

Seniors: In the last 2 weeks we have played both Frankston Pines & Nunawading. In both games our boys have played well seeing a more attacking brand of football without receiving the results that I believe we should have, losing 2-1 and 4-3 respectively. Unfortunately our committee, coaches and players scratch our heads just how unlucky we have been not just over the past two weeks more so this season. Each week our players go out to play the best they can, for our club, themselves and for their coaches and will continue to do so. While there are still 15 points to play for and still a possibility of surviving in State League 3 the equation becomes more difficult each week. I continue to have faith in both our players and our coaches I hope our run of bad luck is over. I ask you to get behind our players as they strive for success for the rest of the season.

Reserves: Our Reserves continue to develop as we see many good young prospects developing from our junior ranks. These lads are the future of our club, part of our long-term vision with many having a taste of senior football throughout the season with some players securing senior positions throughout the year. To those players well done, for those still waiting, your chance I'm sure it will come be patient. Well done last week defeating Nunawading in a come from behind win 5-3, with Matt Wilson scoring a hat trick in his 3rd game back for the club, well done Matt.

Metro6: This team was added to our club at the beginning of the season to further develop senior players for our Saturday teams. Most of these lads are young ex U18s and currently sit in 2nd position on the ladder. Coach by Dave McKinney and managed by Cheryl Miscamble these lads play with spirit and heart each week doing themselves and the club proud. I must thank both Hayden and Blake Hicks who has filled in for the teams injured young keeper Harry and Blake for the injured forward in recent weeks, after playing for the seniors on Saturday and Metro 6 on the Sunday, thank you to you both.

Our Ladies Team: Coached by Kathy Sipcic continue to show their improvement during the season and now currently sit 3rd on the ladder. Our vision of a pathway for our junior girls continues to grow and gain momentum with our junior girls doing exceptionally well this season especially the U12s who won the league with one of our veteran players coaching them, Peter Ascott. Well done to you Peter, and your team.

U35 Bayside: Our U35s currently sit 2nd in the Bayside League and defeated top of the table Dandenong Wolves 2 weeks ago. Keep up the good work lads after an outstanding debut into the league.

Veterans Team: Currently sit on top of the table in this competition, by a point with Montrose in 2nd as they strive for 3 premierships in a row. Tomorrow the boys play Seaford away, next Sunday they are at home against Montrose. If they win this game they will secure something never achieved in the club before 3 in a row. So come down and get behind the boys at 1pm on Sunday 1st September at home.

Winter Ball: For those who attended, Thank you for your support, it was a terrific night for those who couldn't make it you missed out on a great value for money night.

Peninsula Strikers versus Monash University - Result: 0:0 draw

Peninsula Strikers and Monash University have been vying for the top position on the ladder for some weeks and this game was touted as the contest of the season. Matches played at Monash usually take place at 11.00am, so this was quite challenging for our team as it was preceded by the winter ball where drinks were either inclusive or priced to seduce the most conscientious of objectors!
