Welcome back: I would like to welcome back Kristian Miller, Matt Wilson and Matt's parents Eric and Lisa to the club. Both Kristian and Matt played Junior & Senior football for the club and have returned after recently playing at Langwarrin. We are excited to have them back at the club, as our vision to produce a sustainable home grown team / club continues to develop.

Supporters: I ask you to do exactly that, support. Please don't criticise our team or the committee before you have all the information. I understand at times it's frustrating for you, as it is for our players, coaches and the committee. Remember none of us come here to loose or be criticised, believe me we are doing our best to change things around for the club in the long-term, not just for one season. Our vision is for 2013, and beyond. Support our teams the club and the functions we hold as we try to build a club that we can all be proud of, that is able to sustain the changing pressures of a football club. For many years it's been the same, more demands by the FFV, more money and like everyday life there is only so much you can do with what you have, so bear with us as we make solid long-term changes re-structure the club and how we do business. It will take time.

At the moment we are continuing to undertake a 360 degree review looking at what our players, coaches, committee and its members think. Your turn is coming, so sit tight and when your say comes along, please give us your realistic and informed feedback, please remember, to the best of my knowledge this has never been undertaken in the club before.

Irrigation: Our main training ground has now been fitted with irrigation while the extension to the training park now being worked on for the future which includes hopefully another playing ground which will enable the club to expand in the future. This includes a new main water pump which was required after many years of problems with our grounds not seeing regular water on them during the summer.

Training Ground Extension: soil is to be delivered in September with fertiliser and seed for the training ground extension, which will hopefully be ready for season 2014. Once completed, council will provide another set of goals for this ground also. Our vision once completed is to have another set of goals positioned north /south (freeway end/ grandstand) and create another competition ground. This will enable the club to increase its team capacity in the future.

Pavilion upgrade: This document highlighted many things, one being our pavilion, change rooms, being substandard. As a result of this report our facility is high priority and will be the next item on the agenda for the committee to look at with an upgraded expected in 2-3 years, your committee has already had council representative look through our facilities and I am happy to inform you that they are all in agreeance that our facility requires this sooner rather than later, a pleasing outcome!

As I have vigorously lobbied council and the FFV sometime now. Two (2) years ago, I was successful in having our shower facilities upgraded.

I have to say that there are many projects in the future that will require the club to financially contribute to have these projects come to fruition. It's up to you the members of PSFC to look at and support the long-term goals of the committee not just the short term results on the park. Light's and Pavilion come at a cost, we need everyone's support now, not just down the track when you see the results of the hard work happening now.

Training Lights: An update on this project is an unfortunate one with the club not being successful in its application to Sport Victoria on this occasion. This project isn't dead as we will attempt to secure funding via local and federal government politicians with elections not too far away.

Woman's FFV State League 4 South East: A new team to the club this season, after a lot of hard work by their coach Kathy Sipcic. Kathy is also on the committee. Our ladies team was established this season to also include a future pathway for our junior girls. I have to say, this team continues to grow in confidence and skill throughout the season and are now gaining some well-deserved results. Last Sunday against Skye, I had the privilege to assist the ladies as their coach was away. It was an outstanding effort, only to see them run out of substitutes and puff which resulted in a draw, with Skye scoring in the last minute. These young ladies have now won 2, drawn 2 out of their last 6 games, well done girls, keep up the hard work, it's paying off.

Men's FFV Metropolitan 6: Another new team to the club this season, again providing a pathway for young men who didn't make or want to play senior football on a Saturday. This team is coached by the hard working Dave McKinney and managed by Cheryl Miscamble. Dave's team currently are on top of their respective competition ladder. Last Sunday I witnessed there game and there are many in this squad who could and should consider having a crack at Saturday senior football next season. Keep up the fantastic results for the remainder of the season boys, I hope you can win the title and would be just reward for your hard work this season.

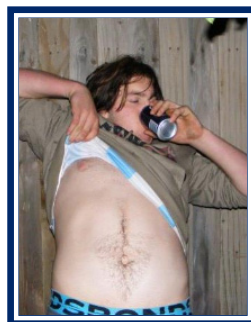

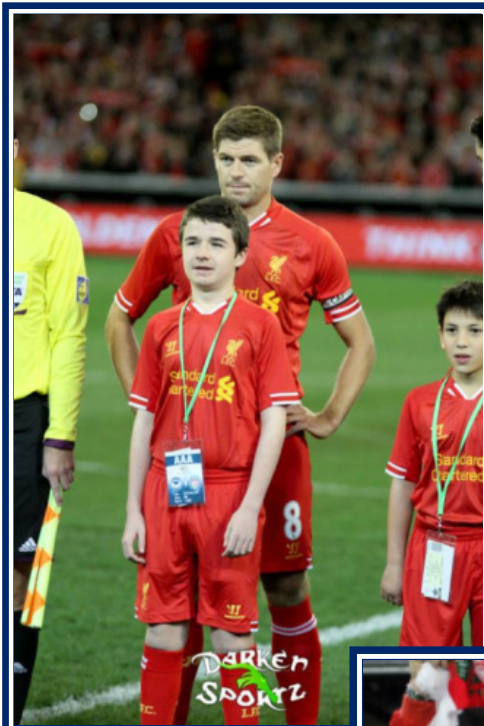
AROUND THE CLUB!
