It gives me great pleasure for those of you whom weren't aware, that our last game against Sandringham where our seniors were outstanding winning 4-1, cemented our place in State 2 Division. We have an outstanding close group of players with us and I will take this opportunity that thank you all once again publicly as I have in already personally. I hope you put on another outstanding performance today and for our last game of the season away to Old Melbourne as we look to building our club to another level in 2016.

To our senior coaches, I thank you for your dedication and support since taking over the reins of the club again, 8 weeks ago. Your support and character have shown what building a team and a club is all about. Thank you once again.

For those of you within our club, your committee are happy to announce that Craig Lewis has been reappointed as senior coach for 2016. Craig's passion for football the players and club is what our club needs moving forward as we build and expand in 2016, congratulations Craig on your reappointment.

Lights / Expansion of Training Ground & Competition Ground

As many of you would have noticed our expansion on the rear ground is taking shape and will be ready for use in 2016. This gives the club another training ground including another competition ground allowing the club to grow and expand.

Our new lights have started with the power cabling now complete with 3 of 4 concrete pads finished awaiting light poles to be fitted etc. These should be finished by the end of September 15. Once this evolution is finished, council will seed the area and we expect for this to be ready in all aspect for next season. Our club contribution is \$10,000 so remember you can help! Clubroom Upgrade / Refurbishment

We continue to move closer to our upgrade / refurbishment after about 40 years. This has been a political hot potato with me since council announced \$545,000 in the 2015/2016 budget, firstly this only allowed for 2 change rooms which doesn't allow for club growth with the anticipated return of a ladies team in 2016, nor did it allow for 2 games to be played simultaneously after our rear park is completed. With the help of Cr Colin Hampton I have been informed that our club will have 4 change rooms included in the upgrade, which is fantastic news for the club. Please, be aware that the cost to the club will be \$15,000, this project should commence at the end of the 2016 season. Drawings should complete in the not too distant future.



Metro 5: Well done to our Metro 5 this season and to Dave McKinney who continues to coach them. Dave has been on both junior then senior committees now for about 9 years and contributes a great deal to the club in many ways. Dave, thank you once again for your support in both coaching / committee this season. Your efforts mostly go under the radar, though definitely not by the committee and your players. I know the team has not been as successful on the park this year after being promoted last year, however, you cannot win every year. Dave, I again thank you on behalf of the club for your dedication that you provide us, I just wish there were more dedicated people such as yourself around, maybe it's because you're a Liverpool supporter lol. Seriously, keep up the great work and thank you once again. To all those who are part of Dave's team well done lads keep up the great spirit and I hope to see you all again next season.

Our Ladies Team: Our Ladies team unfortunately due to a lack of numbers and early support moved to Skye earlier in the year which was a huge loss to the club. In 2016 our club aim will to have ladies football once again which I have been working on since my return as president. 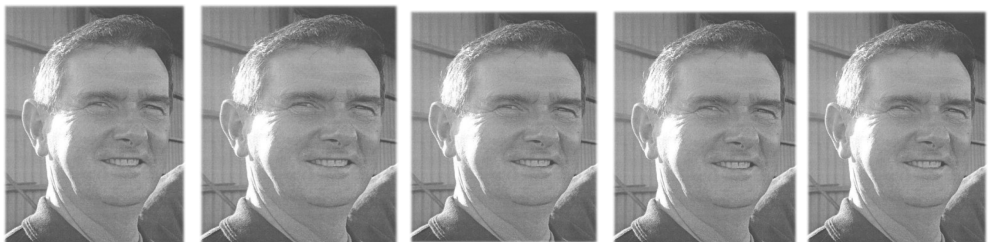

Senior Team Coaches Report

Today we welcome Doveton to McClelland Drive, for what is our final home game of the season 2015.

Over the past month or so our results have not been what we would have hoped for, particularly with regards the Dingley game away. This is a game we all would have marked down as a three pointer, particularly going in at half time 2-0 up against a side struggling at the foot of the table. We missed many chances in the first half and were made to suffer drastically in the second half with a very poor performance eventually losing 3-2. A very disappointing day for all concerned at the club.

A home loss against Old Scotch the following week and an Old Melbournian win meant the gap at the bottom of the table was evaporating quickly. It appeared we were in end of season mode with some poor lacklustre performances. It was time to switch on or face a relegation scrap.

We then travelled away to Heatherton with a determination to get a win on the board, but most importantly bring back some of the self confidence that had been lacking in the weeks previous. A good start to the game with us leading 1-0 from an opportunist goal from Hoppy, however a lapse at the back allowed Heatherton to equalise from a penalty kick. With Heatherton reduced to ten men late in the first half, we had to re-adjust our team structure and to make the most of the opportunity against 10 men. After a disastrous 10 minute spell at the beginning of the second half, we found ourselves down 3-1 due to some poor defending and lack of discipline. The excitement wasn't over and a great strike from Amir brought us back into the game with approximately 15 minutes remaining. We continued to spread the ball into wide areas and eventually won a free kick on the right hand side of the box near the touchline. Up stepped Iba to bend his free kick into the far left hand corner of the net to bring us level. A truly fantastic goal indeed. With all the play and pressure continuing from our players, a crossed ball into the box saw Ali rise above the defence only to see his head crash off the bar and away to safety. Almost full time and Heatherton broke forward and had a match winning chance to steal the points, however the ball came off the underside of the bar and away to safety. Final whistle, 3-3. A heart stopping second half. Although we didn't take the 3 points, we showed the character and determination that had been lacking in the previous month to show that we still had something in the tank going into the last few matches.

Up next was Sandringham away, which if we reflect on the first game against Sandringham at home, where we were comprehensively beaten 4-0. We were going to be up against a very strong, physical side and if we weren't switched on, would face a long day at the office.

The buzz in the dressing room was apparent before the game as was the intensity and focus during the pre-match warm up. We welcomed back Tas from a brief spell away and he went straight into the back four to add some vital experience in a game we needed to win and to ensure our performance was at the required level.

The game kicked off and within the first 10 to 15 minutes we should have been 3 or 4 goals up. Some brilliant build up play and chances being created, we were unfortunately not rewarded for our good start to the game. However we were not to be denied our dominance and Luke popped up at the back post to slot away our first of the afternoon. Not long before half time we managed to get our second of the afternoon from a right foot strike from Amir. The game was being controlled and we were looking good. Half time 2-0 up. Things were looking good.

Discussions took place at half time around being 2-0 up at half time (a similar score against Dingley weeks earlier which we eventually lost) and the determination was there from all that we would learn from past errors. Once again we started brightly in the second half and stuck to our game plan. Sandringham were pushing forward in numbers to try and get a foothold back in the game, however our speed and direct play in break way situations led us to stream forward time and time again which would result in us winning a corner. The ball was whipped into the box and the ball fell kindly to Lindrium and he coolly slotted it past the keeper to make it 3-0. Finally it felt like we had some breathing space. Not to be, as shortly after, a long ball forward caught our defence napping which allowed Sandringham's forward to run clear through and slot it past our keeper Jason. Sandringham were fighting hard to get back into the game, however after a prolonged period of pressure, we once again broke forward with pace and opened up the Sandringham defence. Ali, who had worked his back side off all day, finally got his reward with a clinical strike across the keeper to make it 4-1 to the Strikers. The relief amongst the coaching staff, the bench and supporters was clear to see. It appeared we would get a win against a very good, strong Sandringham side away from home against all odds. As it happened, we had another 2 chances to add to the goal tally, however with the final whistle blowing, we managed to win the game 4-1. An outstanding effort from all. Reflecting on this performance, **I can hold my hand on heart and say that it was our most complete, disciplined performance of the season.**

Not long after the final whistle, news came through that Old Scotch had beaten Old Melburnians which meant that we had maintained our standing in State League Division 2 for another season with 2 games remaining.

So onto the last home game against Doveton today. We will maintain our determination to put on a good performance in front of our home supporters for the final time this season. Hopefully we can get another 2 wins to see us rise up the table further.

On a personal note, I would like to take the opportunity of thanking my playing group, my coaching staff, the President Mark Brandon, the standing committee, the volunteers who have helped out this year and the parents who travel week in and week out to support their kids. It has been a difficult year, however I am so very pleased that we have built a fantastic group of young men who have tried their very best to represent the Peninsula Strikers the best they can. The club is in good hands and with 9 or 10 of the playing group under the age of 21, the club can be sure that the future looks bright.

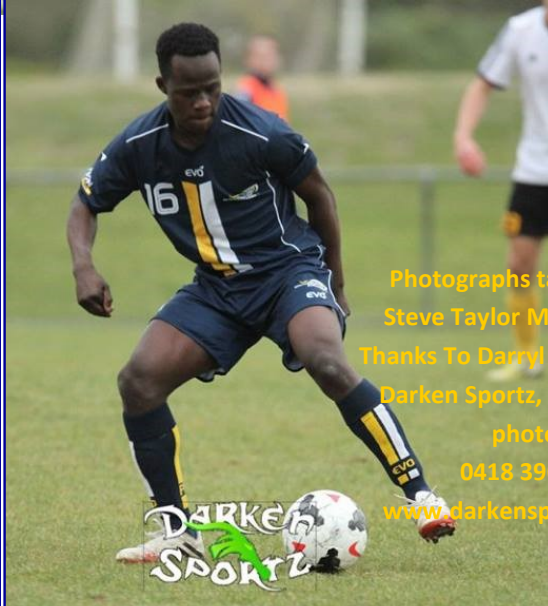
