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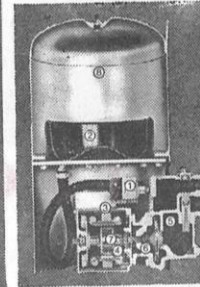
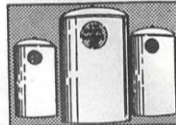

ALL ABOUT K.U.S.C.

Karingal United Soccer Club was formed in 1967 with two Junior teams; it now runs teams in all age groups from U8 to U16 years, it also has an U20 and Senior and Reserve team - this represents 180 boys under 16 years and 50 senior players.

This being the first widespread publication of 'THE K.U.S.C. NEWSLETTER', the Building Committee would like to put all its readers in the picture as to what the Club is trying to achieve for itself and also the residents of the area.

Over the past two years the Club has been working towards building a Sports and Recreation Centre at Ballan Park.

THE NEW K.U.S.C. COMPLEX (.../contd.)

After approaching Council and having Plans drawn up and approved, we secured a site at Ballan Park. Council approved a grant of \$20,000 towards the cost of building (estimated cost \$50,000 plus \$6,000 sewerage),

To raise the necessary finance the Club formed a Co-op. which will enable us to raise a Bank Loan of \$18,000; the balance to be raised by the Building Committee by way of Dances, Walkathons, Public Donations etc.. The Committee would welcome help from any source with its fund raising activities - any help, suggestions or advice should be directed to Mr. Ron Owens (789.2560).

To qualify for the Council Grant a start must be made to the Building by September. We now await Council Health Dept. approval and then we go to Tender.
