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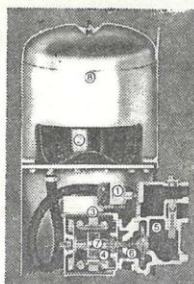
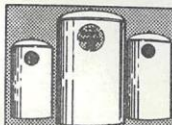
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RESIGNATION:

CO-OPERATIVE SOCIETY NEWS:

The Club's Co-operative Society's application for a Government Guarantee was deferred recently. This additional frustration resulted in the Society's five Directors having to do an urgent door knock to sign up twenty-six new shareholders who would be prepared to act as guarantors for the \$18,000 loan for the proposed new clubhouse.

All five Directors were heartened by the enthusiastic response of people approached and thank them for their help.

Nett Result - 28 new shareholders and the application for a Government Guarantee was approved on 8th July.

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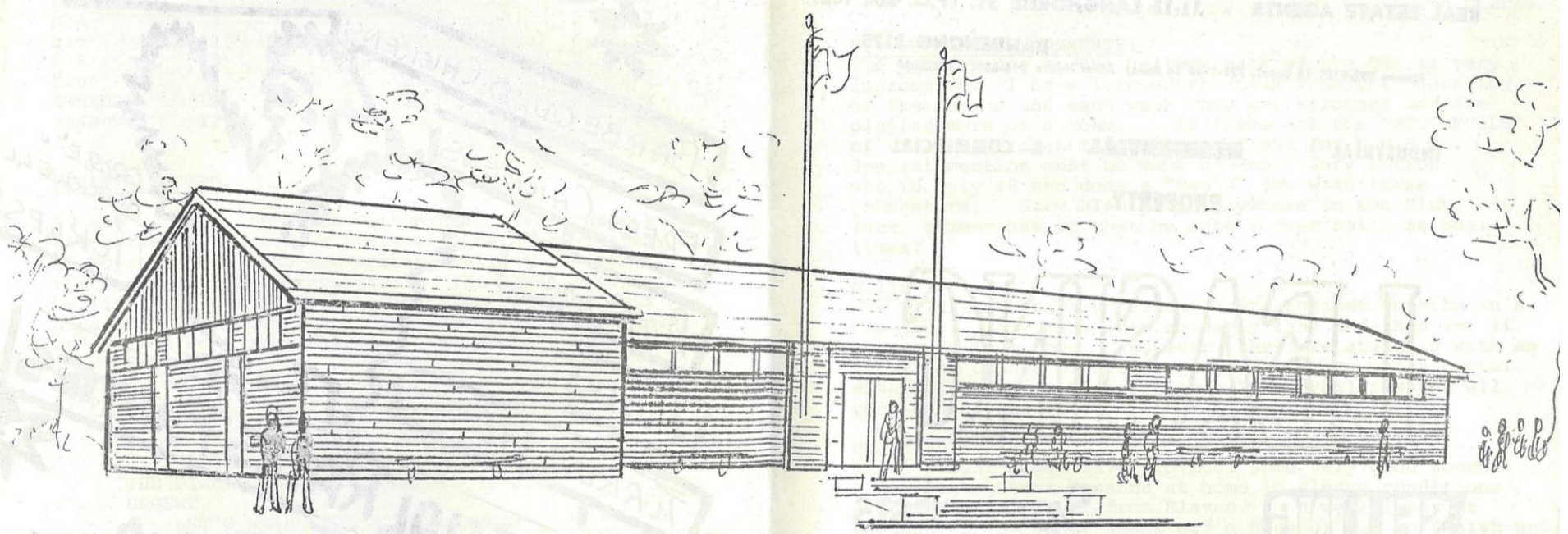
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TEAM REPORTS:

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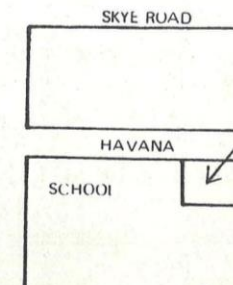
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
