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COACHES REPORT

I welcome this opportunity to inform club members of the inside information on what's going on with the playing side of KARINGAL this season. As you would imagine I was quite distressed to see the good work we had done over a four year period almost destroyed by last years pathetic performance on the field of play. Without going into the reasons behind last years poor effort, we are looking to turn the situation around as quickly and efficiently as possible.

Certainly the club's performance off the field was highly successful and deserving of much better result. Knowing KARINGAL as I do because of a lengthy stay in the past, I feel that there is no excuse for a club of our standing to be in any other situation but one of being the best on the peninsula or even the state. It is my intention with the help of the other members of the playing committee to revamp the whole situation and re-kindle the success of previous years and then look forward to advancing beyond that.

Since the invitation to rejoin KARINGAL a month ago, I have taken time to assess the situation and put in place the necessary action to improve our situation. Some problems were obvious from the outset.

- a) The lack of experience in the Senior teams.
- b) The lack in numbers of playing staff.
- c) The lack of professionalism.

I have stated to the playing staff that I would sign 8-10 players should we be able to do so in the short term. This is not to sign a whole new first team as much to add those numbers to the Senior Squad, to bring extra experience and provide competition for places and atmosphere.

Improvements to attitude will soon be apparent in our young stars such as Craig Miller, Mark Herron, Paul Moore, Bernie McGuinness and Steve Griffin if they are given more experienced players to play with.

They will also improve much more quickly in ability when playing in a more capable side. It is also a common fact that players in the Senior Squad will be happy in the 2nd string as long as that side is performing well and winning. Our current senior players, Kevin Burrough, Kevin Moore, John Rowe, Tim Dillon and Keith Towers will blossom with a stronger team as will the younger 1st teamers Andy Durieux, Ray Kren, Steve Dobinson and others. It must be pointed out that only one of the players I have mentioned is over 25.

So who's coming to KARINGAL ?. We have already signed FRED CANTSILIERIS, Langwarrins " Coaches Player of the Year " in 1985.

At 27 Fred, an Egyptian, is a neat skillful player. He is yet to get fit however and once he achieves this we will benefit greatly from his skillful play. We have also signed PETER TUCKETT, 25, a front runner who will add much needed punch to our attack. Peter is strong, very fast and has a keen eye for goals.

We also hope to sign MARK REES a centre back and JIM KERR a midfielder, at the moment they are still at Langwarrin and negotiations are taking place between the clubs. Both are very experienced players and have a strong appetite for the game.

Steve Taylor has re-joined the club, Steve another front player with excellent technique, joins younger brother Michael, who is on the brink of 1st team selection. There is a possibility that Andy Taylor, a former 1st team striker, may also be persuaded to return.

Andy Wright has also returned to the club after work commitments to boost the playing staff to 30. Andy of course adds much strength to the team and has always very popular at Karingal. Mick Donnelly an experienced goalie supports that area giving an ideal situation of two senior goalkeepers allowing a young star Craig Miller time to develop.
