Please give them all your support

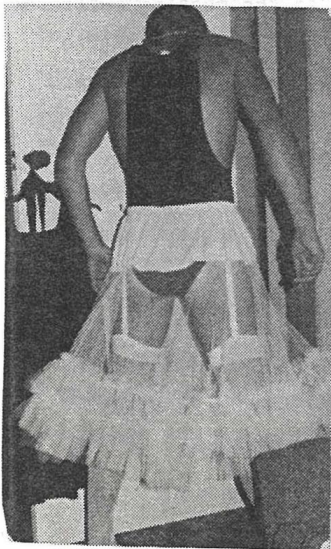
