At the beginning of this season things at the Senior level looked a little bleak. We have also lost Bernie McGuinness for a couple of years after he re-broke his leg in a pre-season friendly. However, what developed during pre-season training was a tremendous team spirit, brought about by the fact that the majority of players were Karingal boys and Karingal minded. We again lost Steve Dobinson just as he was showing 1st team potential. All in all it is the best start to a season for some while and we hope to maintain it. After watching the U/16 and U/14 recently, I am sure that there is plenty of talent to follow.
