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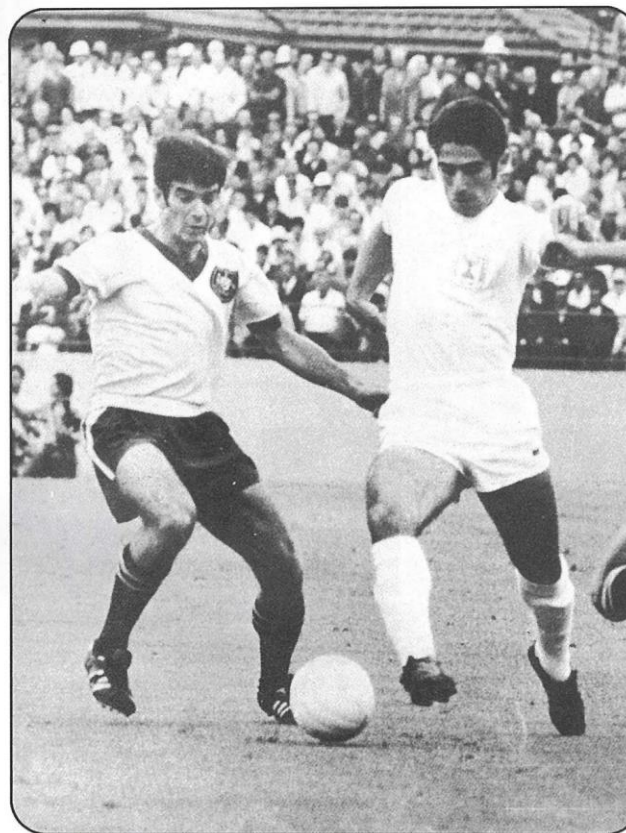

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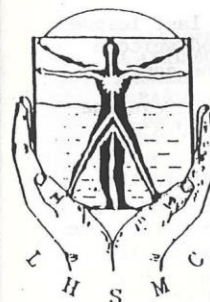

20.30 *Reserve side awards (best player, top scorer)*

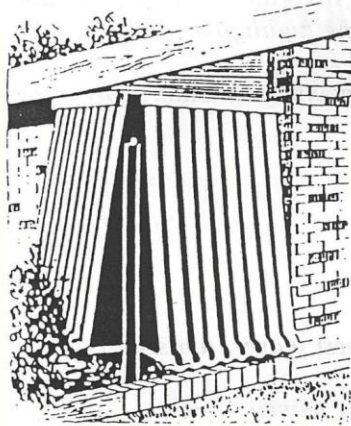

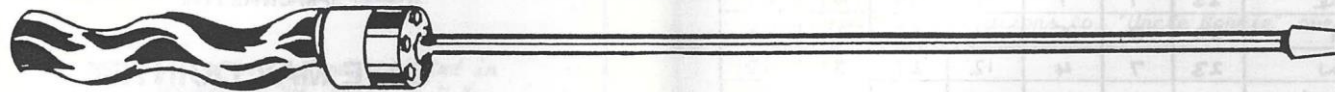
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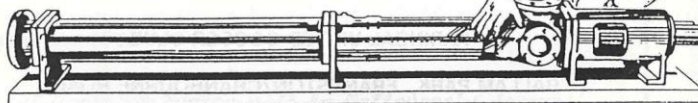
