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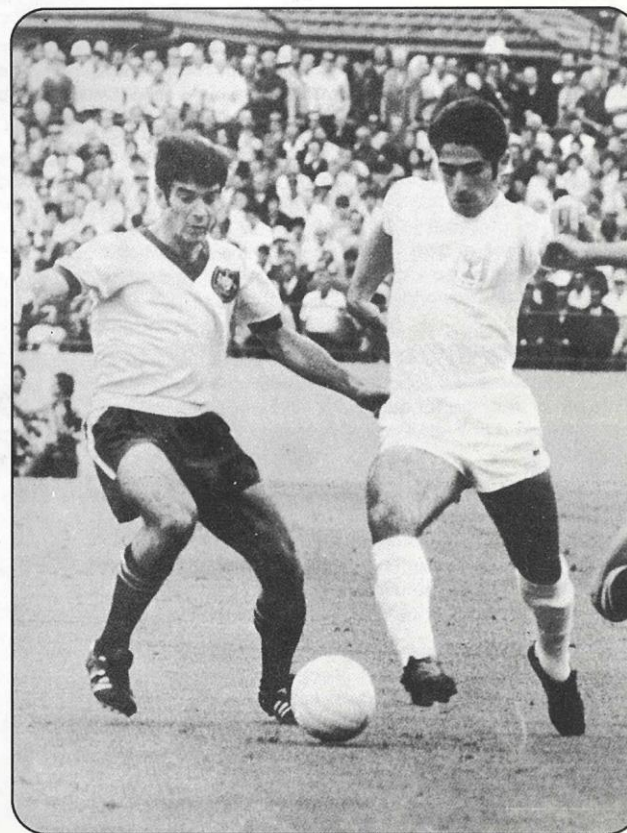

We had quite a few outings including the National League final between Sth Melbourne and Melbourne Croatia, the VFL Night Footy at the MCG, several trips to McDonalds and a pre game breakfast at the Club. We also had a great night at the Club with Socceroo Captain Paul Wade and Geoff Olver at the Sports Night.
