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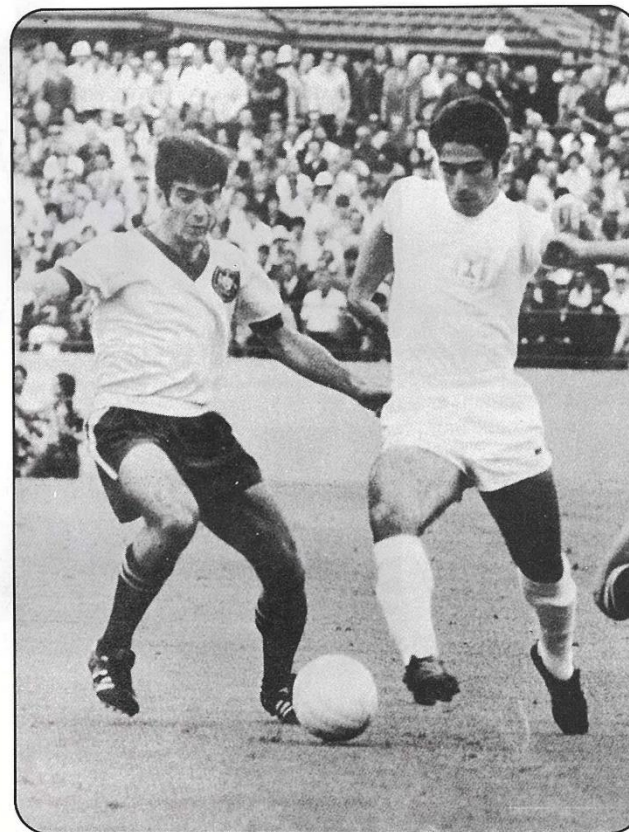

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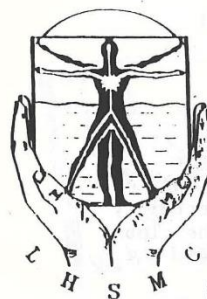

RESERVES

Wet, windy and cool conditions greeted us for our home game against Boronia, a welcome relief from the high temps of late.

Shortly after this Karingal was reduced to ten men, having Sticky go off injured and already having used both subs. Karingal now with this added pressure handled the remaining 30 minutes of the game with good commitment from all players and possibly could have snatched victory when a Steve Dobinson effort went agonisingly close.

A good point earned and I am sure with some hard work, we will improve in future games.

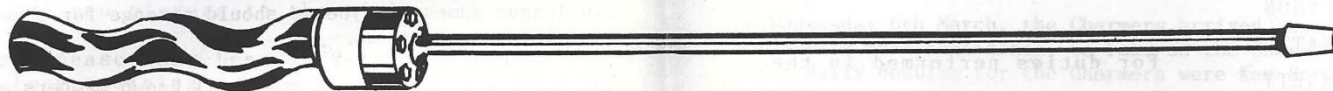
The darts teams play their Home games on Wednesday nights at the club, starting 8.00pm. The Devilettes would welcome any support, come along have a drink and cheer us on.

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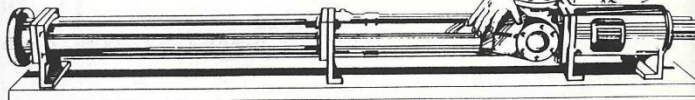

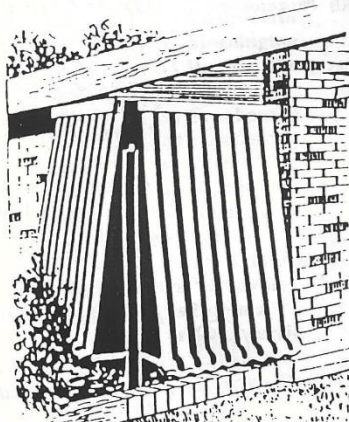

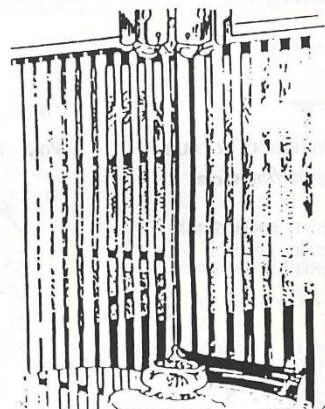
