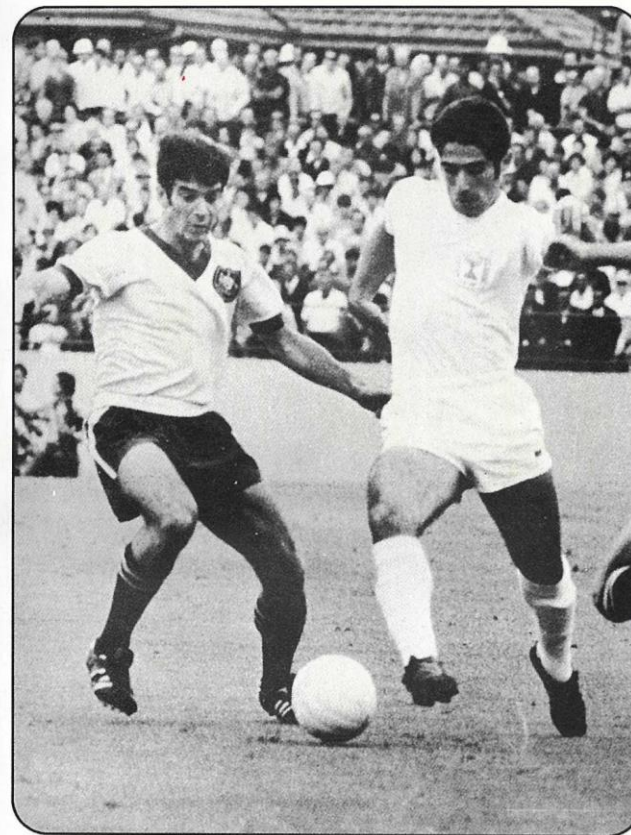

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"Reserve" Coaches Report

The events of last Saturday at Coburg will remain a memory of disgust in my own mind for years to come. However, the one good point to come out of a disastrous trip, was the conduct which the reserve team players displayed in the face of disgraceful adversity and intimidation. I was proud of the discipline shown by the players in holding their emotions in check at the end of the game when the opposition were "spoiling" for a fight.

My heart goes out to Kevin Jones on breaking his leg again. The tackle was criminal and I promise Kevin now that I will do whatever is necessary in my power to assist him in his recovery. I can understand his depression at the moment and I call on all his friends and team mates to rally round and lift his spirits.

The attack on Tony Barrett can be described as nothing less than "animalistic". In fact, in my opinion, this is an insult to animals. The modern day "Dracula" attack may have seemed funny to some but Tony must now spend the next 3 months of worry and stress before having to take an aids test. I have talked to some medical friends and they have told me his chances of contracting the disease are microscopic. The worry is still there though despite these re-assurances.

The Committee, Lou and myself have forwarded lengthy detailed and extensive reports on the incidents to the V.S.F. and the police at Coburg and their reaction so far has been one of absolute disgust. Apologies have been received from Terry Jones, the head of the V.S.F. with a promise that the severest of action will be taken against North Coburg. Hopefully, that will mean that they will be eliminated from the competition for good.

On to the details of the game, we lost 1-0 and quite frankly, we deserved no less than a hiding. It seems a mystery to me though because the first 25 minutes belonged entirely to Karingal. We out-fought and out-played the opposition and then for some reason, we went to sleep. Our skill value was well down and I am afraid to say that some players gave it away. We will not tolerate this and changes will have to be made. Some players have had a reasonable run without performing. Injuries have not helped with the list getting longer. Richie May, Bobby Geddes, Gary Black, Sean Uden, Victor Wotherspoon, Rob Harris, Neil Wainwright and now Kevin Jones have all been sidelined with injury. Once we have the majority of these players back, we will be strong as a squad.

In contrast, the previous week, we defeated Heidelberg City convincingly 3-0 with goals from Steve Jones (2) and Gary Black. We played some good soccer, created chances and took them. Our defence was reasonably stable while Jonesy was causing the opposition problems up front. The boys turned in a creditable performance.

This week, we are at home to Yarraville and I am expecting a performance like the one against Heidelberg City a fortnight ago. Although we have many injuries, we still have a strong squad and I am looking for a vastly improved performance on last weeks effort.

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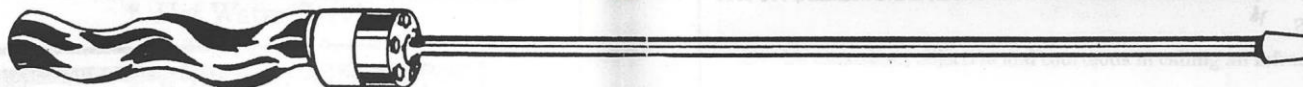
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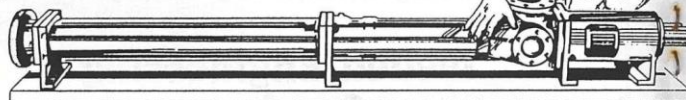


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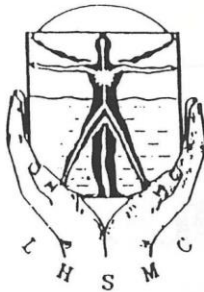

6. Demonstrate appropriate social behaviour by not using foul language, harrassing players, coaches or officials.

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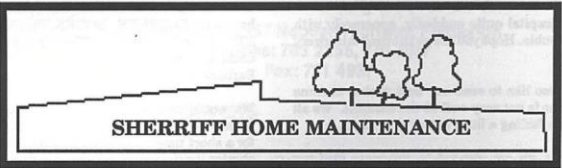
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News from around the Club
