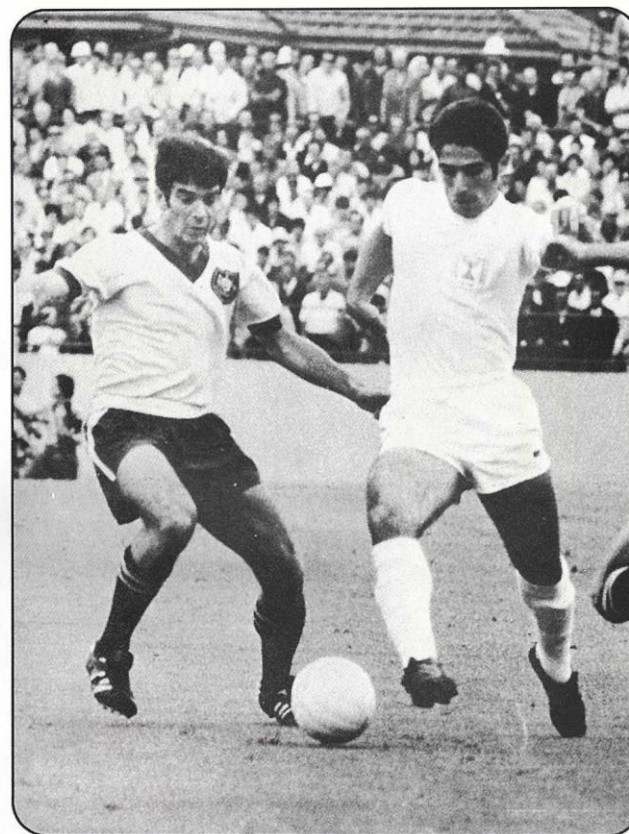

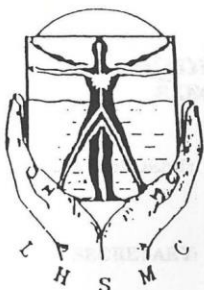
President's Message

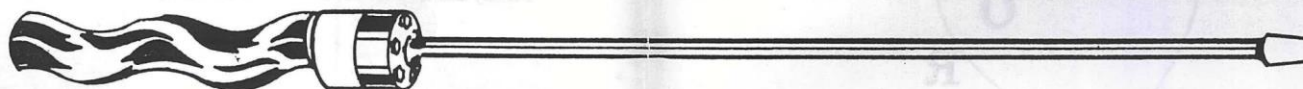

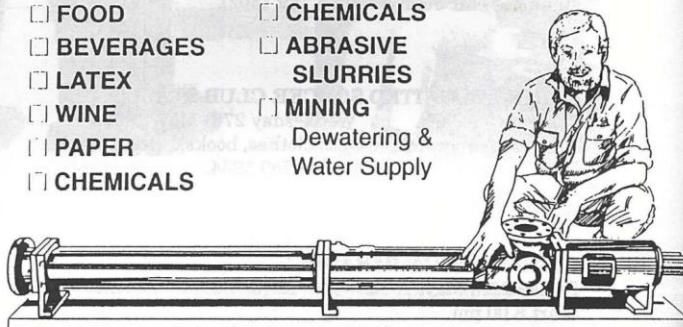

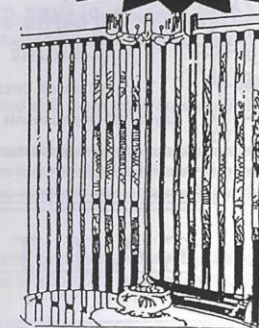
