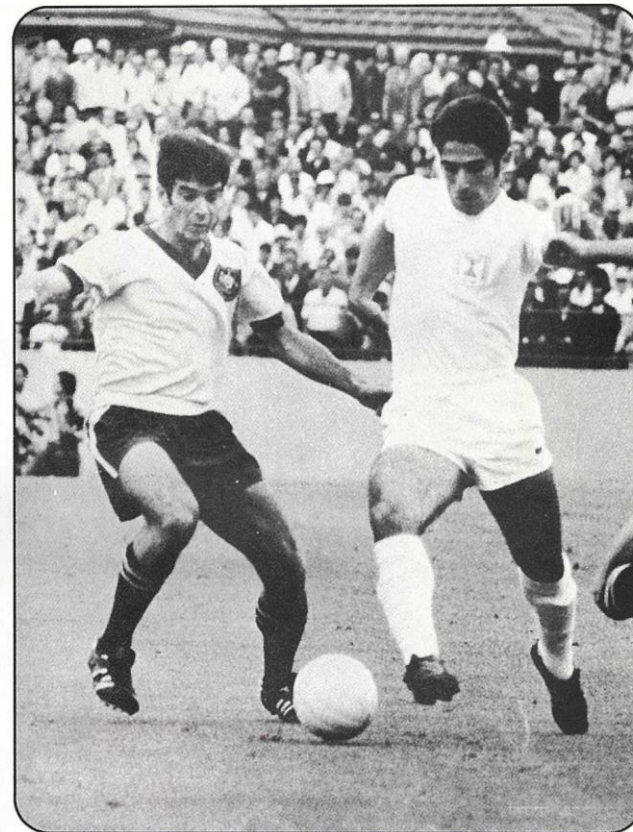

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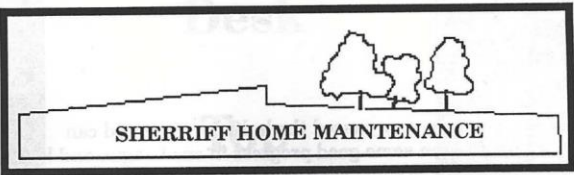
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Under 16 Squad

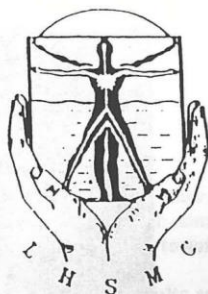

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"Reserve" Coaches Report

Karingal reserves team had mixed fortune over the last two weeks, with a 1-2 home defeat by Hawthorn Citizens, followed by a good 3-1 victory at Heidelberg City last weekend.

Against Hawthorn, we were basically inferior in most departments. Although they tried successfully to intimidate us throughout the game, I was displeased with the organization, discipline and attitude of the players. We conceded a goal in the first couple of minutes, followed quickly by a second, both goals being caused by our inability to close opposition players down. Tony Barrett was sent off which left us with 10 men for three quarters of the game. Our control and disposal was woeful and it is coming very close to the time when players have to stand up and be counted. We have worked all year on the basics of the game, passing, control, support, disposal, chipping etc., and some players are still trying to play "kick and rush." It cannot carry on. It seems players think that because they have run around like "headless chooks" for 90 minutes, they have done their bit. They could not be further from the truth.

Here is a list of 10 points I want the reserve team to think very seriously about for the remainder of the season.

1. **Concentration:** For 90 minutes on your basic skills, controlling, disposing of and correctly weighting the ball.
2. **Anticipation:** Always believe that your team mate will win the ball and use you.
3. **Positioning:** Support your team mate by finding the space or correct angle to run into.
4. **Frustration:** Don't hang your head and moan if you make a mistake. Get on with the job.
5. **Discipline:** Remember, you represent the club. Don't be intimidated and accept refereeing decisions. They will not change their minds.
6. **Organization:** Stick to the game plan. Each of you has a job to do. One not doing their job makes it more difficult for the other 10 to do their jobs.
7. **Pride:** Have pride in representing your club, for yourself and team mates.
8. **Determination:** Be determined to do well for the club on the field. At times, that determination and commitment will carry you through to victory.
9. **Communication:** You can win a game by supplying the right information to a colleague, without even touching the ball. Remember, eyes, brain and mouth are more important than the feet.
10. **Vision:** Think ahead, believe in yourself and team mates and concentrate on getting the basics right - Remember, CONTROL - LOOK - PASS - MOVE.

Against Heidelberg City, at least we improved in some areas. I am encouraged that we continue to create a good number of chances per game and if we had taken only half of them, we would have had the league won by now. However, Steve Dobbo came down to the reserves and scored twice. Blacky scored another cracker and once again, we hit the woodwork. Conditions were difficult but I was pleased to come away with both points.

This week, North Coburg are our opponents. The least said about the past, the better. I expect my players to conduct themselves in exemplary fashion without provocation. If we play the way we have done in earlier games this season, the two points we gain will be more than adequate reward. I remind everyone concerned with the reserve side. Any slip-ups in discipline today, will be dealt with in the most severest of methods by myself and the committee. Let's beat them by playing the better soccer. IAN.

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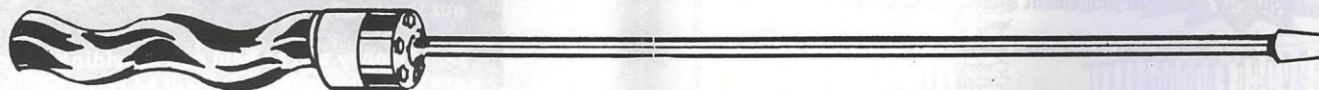
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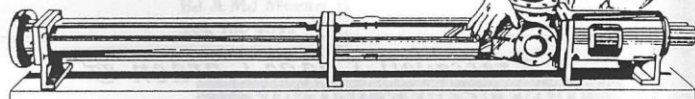
