ROBINSON ROAD PARK

It is now two years since Frankston City Soccer Club withdrew from the Soccer Federation, which left the McClelland Drive ground vacant.

The Club Committee decided to lobby local council with a view to gaining the complex, however, due to various leases and money owing to Frankston City, council advised the club that we could not possibly get the ground.

Council however, was sympathetic to us, having proved we were a Frankston based club desiring to play in Frankston, they offered us a ground to be developed namely, Robinson Road.

Over the past eighteen months we have seen the development of this area so much so that two pitches will be available to us next season. The probability is that we won't have a Club House built by council, however, we can supply temporary accomodation at our own expense until funds are available to build clubrooms.

Many of you will realise that in trying to cater for a large amount of boys our Skye Balarto Road ground has proven inadequate. The U7 pitch was constructed by parents at a cost to the club of \$1000 in order to increase the size of the second large ground.

Despite all this, we have struggled to accomodate our teams and without the sincere help of the new Committee at Frankston Carrum Soccer Club who allowed us to share the facilities at McClelland Drive, we would have had to lose some teams.

Frankston Carrum Soccer Club invited several of the Committee to meet with them with a view to sharing their ground, however, despite the magnificent clubrooms the area compared with Robinson Road would still be inadequate to cater for our needs both now and certainly for the future.

Undoubtably, we shall not sever the relationship we have with Frankston Carrum Soccer Club as both they and us are desirous of improving soccer in general on the Peninsula and more importantly in Frankston.

The Committee invite any interested parents to take a look at the Robinson Road reserve, the entrance is just past the Lakewood Estate on Robinson Road, feel free to ask exactly where and how to enter the ground.
