**** NEW HOME**

Next Sunday, 18th May, we are moving to our magnificent new home at Robinson's Park. The two teams privileged to christen the new pitches are the under 12's at 11.00 a.m. and the under 13 A's at 12.00.

Both teams are playing cup games.

It has been unfortunate that the drought delayed our move to the new ground, but I am sure we will benefit from our patience in letting the grass become more established.

I am hopeful that water and electricity will be connected to the Clubhouse in the next few weeks, but in the mean time, we will improvise with gas stoves, water containers, and gas lights. If anybody has a generator they are prepared to donate for weekend use, I would love to hear from you!

Conditions of the ground allocation include:-

- ** 2 only senior pitches**
- ** maximum 3 hours usage per pitch per week**
- ** hooks will be fitted to goal posts during the season.**

Application is being lodged with Council for the provision of permanent Clubrooms. If successful, we could occupy the new building by the 1988 season. A copy of the proposed plan is posted on the Club notice board.

A great number of people must be thanked for their contribution over the past three years in achieving this goal. I apologise for not naming everyone, but I must thank the "prime movers" Danny Burrows, Mike Storer, Tony Hall, Marilynne Duffy, Councillors Peter Love, Ted Holman, Gary Burleigh and Albert Knowles for the background work done in setting up the Club for allocation of 5 soccer pitches at Robinson's Park.

In more recent months, while most of us were just starting to think about soccer, a small band of hard working parents were erecting the new "palatial" Clubrooms. OK, a tin shed - but two rooms, and carpeted floor, plus many more home comforts to come over the next few weeks. Anyway, you'll all see it happen for yourselves and hopefully contribute ideas, labour or furnishings to help develop the best TEMPORARY Clubhouse on the Peninsula.

Our resident builder, Danny Anderson has spearheaded our building project with the help of David Mills, Graham Baulk, Mike Duffy, Ron Phillips, Lou Cibura, Glen Charles, Terry Kingston and others. I sincerely thank all our helpers and their understanding families.

Tony founded the Skye Rovers Soccer Club in 1978. In 1979, he saw 50 boys playing in 3 under 7 teams, an under 9 and an under 10 team. The Club grew continuously over the following years, and now has 160 junior members. Tony proudly recalls that the Clubhouse in 1980 was the present "green shed", with the new Clubhouse being built in 1981.

It seems we are going through the same sort of process again at Robinson's Park, but on a larger scale.

Tony has had a strong influence over the direction and the day to day running of the Club, including finding the first home for the Club at Skye Reserve, selecting and purchasing the strip, coaching, securing coaches and managers, care of the pitches, fund raising and many other activities.

The 150th Anniversary Award is presented to people who have made significant contributions to the community. Tony is a very worthy recipient of this award. Thanks and congratulations from all of us Tony!!
